#### MINUTES OF GENERAL MEETING

### March 7, 1979

President Pete Walker called the meeting to order.

Called for the Secretary to read the minutes from the previous meeting.

Called for additions or corrections.

Minutes approved as read.

About 25 members were present.

Donald Nelson gave the Council an update on the Levee Project.

Mr. Nelson stated that the funding for the Levee Project was not in the President's budget. This will make it necessary for Congress to include the project in a funding bill this year if construction is to begin in 1980 as scheduled. The Corps is requesting about \$3,000,000 for fiscal year 1980 as they feel that would be the capability for that year. The first work will start on Fir Island with the right bank of the North Fork and the left bank of the South Fork scheduled for the following year. (1981)

No report has been completed for the Nookachamps study at this time.

A draft design memorandum and Environmental Impact Statement will be ready for public review about May 1, 1979. The Nookachamps report is intended to be ready for this publication. The public will have 45 days to review and comment on this document.

Several questions were asked from the floor:

Question: Where are we on right-of-way surveys and who is responsible?

Mr. Nelson responded that his department of the Skagit County Engineers was responsible. Right-of-way maps for Phase I have been completed and right-of-way descriptions are being prepared by his department. As all right-of-way acquired will come under Federal Regulations for right-of-way acquisition, his department will acquire the additional right-of-way.

Question: What would be the public use of the dikes? Could the dikes be fenced and could cattle be grazed on the dikes?

Considerable discussion took place on this question. Mr. Nelson stated as far as Corps policy was concerned, public use was up to the local authority and would stay much the same as present. Cattle can graze the dike and it may be fenced providing gates were placed at the cross fences. Some objection was raised concerning cattle and fences on the dikes. Discussion continued on policing and liability on the dikes. No conclusion was made, however, and it was stated that a uniform approach should be taken regarding these questions. The Board will approach these questions and made a recommendation.

President Walker presented the Council with a proposal to assist Skagit County in financing the local portion of the Levee Project. The President and Board feel expenses to the Dike Districts will be considerably reduced upon completion of the Levee Project. As this will be a great benefit to the Districts, a portion of present assessments could be channeled to Skagit County to offset a part of the local cost. About 50¢ per \$1,000 of valuation was suggested as a reasonable amount.

The Council discussed this proposal to some length. The consensus was that the proposal was a fair approach but more time was needed to discuss the proposal within the individual Districts and firm up the details on the amount of assessment and method of assessing was needed before a conclusion could be reached.

The Board will study the proposal in more detail at the next Board Meeting in April and call a meeting of the Council in May and present a recommendation.

No further business. The meeting was adjourned.
