1. Skagit River Basin Planning - In response to a request from Mr. George Dynes, I called Lloyd Johnson, Skagit County Engineer, about arrangements for a meeting with the newly formed County Flood Control Committee.

2. Mr. Johnson said that the committee had just been appointed and would be formally organized early in February. He suggested that the committee should first hold an organization meeting and then establish a meeting in which we would outline basin planning requirements. A tentative date of the evening of 2 March was set for this meeting. We anticipate that the District Engineer will participate in the meeting, and Miss Chase was notified.

3. I proposed to Mr. ~~Johnson~~ ^{Johnson} that the committee consider calling itself a Water Resource Planning Committee rather than a Flood Control Committee so that they can start out with the objective of having a comprehensive look at all aspects of water resources planning rather than limit themselves to flood control. This approach would make it possible for us to work with the committee on our PS&AW planning as well as flood control. (GEDNEY)
