This is in response to your letter of 1 March 1977 asking that the Skagit County Flood Insurance Study be expedited.

I am pleased to advise you that our study results will be available incrementally, as listed below, prior to completion of the final report:

Samish River	1 September 1977
Suiattle River	1 October 1977
Baker River	1 February 1978
Sauk River	1 May 1978
Cascade River	1 June 1978
Skagit River	1 July 1978

These are the dates when preliminary flood plain maps and profiles will be available for review. The entire study, including the above items, remains scheduled for completion in September 1979. Although these schedules are subject to change, I want to assure you that the Seattle District will make every effort to provide you the needed information in a timely manner.

I apologize for taking so long to answer your letter, but the time was needed to review our workload.
