BIG MEETING TO BE HELD SOON TO PLAN DRAINAGE DISTRICT

LAND OWNERS TO DIS-CUSS DRAINING PROBLEMS

Thousands of Acres to Be Drained, if Plans Are Carried Out; To Meet at Commercial Club.

A meeting will be held in the near future of all those interested in the project of draining the thousands of acres of land north and east of Sedro-Woolley. It is probable that the meeting will be held next week. This will be announced in next week's issue of the Courier-Times.

The Sedro-Woolley Commercial club extends an invitation to all people interested in this drainage scheme to attend the meeting which will be held at the club rooms on Metcalf street. At this meeting the boundaries of the drainage district will be decided. The district, it is planned, will embrace all of the territory from Minkler creek to Austin, and from the Skagit river to the foot of the hill on the north.

Those who attend this meeting will probably decide on the several outlets for the district, and make preliminary plans. The county engineer will be guided largely by the opinions expressed as to the best location for the main line ditches in the big system which must be worked out.

The Sedro-Woolley Commercial club, as an organization, is planning this meeting for the advancement of the interests of those most concerned, and for the entire district. It is planned to serve refreshments at the meeting, which will be held in the afternoon. Definite date and more details will be announced next week.
