Few Votes Are Being Cast On Flood Control

Lack of interest in today's election to determine whether most of Skagit county shall organize itself into a flood control district was indicated this afternoon. A check of the Mount Vernon precincts showed that only 73 had turned out to make their choice up until after 1 o'clock this afternoon.

Only 2 had voted at the Schlanser precinct and only 7 at the Methodist church. Votes in other precincts up until 1 o'clock were: Jost residence 14, city hall 8, Polson residence 11, Parish house 8, First Lutheran 14, and Henshaw residence 9.

Election officials reported they were finding it extremely difficult to keep busy because of the few votes being cast.

The Daily Herald will keep open house to receive and tabulate returns so that the result of the election can be given the public as soon as possible.
