THE SKAGIT COUNTY HEARING EXAMINER WILL CONTINUE A PUBLIC HEARING ON **WEDNESDAY, June 12, 2013**, IN THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS HEARING ROOM, 1800 CONTINENTAL PLACE, MOUNT VERNON, WASHINGTON, AT THE HOUR OF 9:00 A. M. OR SOON THEREAFTER FOR THE FOLLOWING:

## **CONTINUATION OF PUBLIC HEARING:**

This hearing continues the public hearing held on April 24<sup>th</sup>, 2013 for the eastern extension of the levee maintenance project initiated by the City of Burlington, and Skagit County Dike, Drainage and Irrigation District No. 12, intended to increase flood protections for the City of Burlington. Skagit County Dike, Drainage and Irrigation District No. 12 propose to enlarge both the width and the height of the existing Skagit River levee along the 1.53 mile long project site. The elevation at the top of the levee will be increased by approximately 4 feet in height and the toe or base of the levee will be increased by approximately 60 feet in width. The widening of the dike will be limited to an area landward of the existing levee toe.
