Dear Mr. Stewart:— I have made examination for high water marks at Reflector Bar and find as follows.

Drift - sticks and bark at ga. ht.	16.3
Coarse wash sand " " "	19.
Fine sand, probably wash, " " "	22.

I found no evidence of wash sand above 22. and no coarse sand there, but there is no doubt about the wash sand at 19. I find that in several places but only up to 19. I found it on the flat at that elevation as well as on rocks. Above 22 everything seems to be dirt and decomposed rock. Drift at 16.3 does not appear to be very old and was probably put there in 1909 though it would seem to be most too high for that. I found marks as well defined in first gulch above gaging station as in other so used that as there is less chance for error with hand level.
