

## DAMS MENACE SALMON RUNS

Stating that new proposals for dams in state waters are threatening the very existence of Washington's salmon runs, Milo Moore, state director of fisheries, has announced creation of a new division of his department to determine the requirements of fish life at these new developments.

Lloyd A. Royal has been named biologist in charge of the new division. Royal gained considerable experience in this field before enlisting in the navy three years ago.

Vigorous planning and a sensible distribution of available water supplies are the only means of providing a balanced state economy, said Moore in announcing plans for the new division.
