

## Legislative study of Avon Bypass resolution okayed

A resolution calling for a legislative-interim study of the proposed Skagit River bypass at Avon has been passed by the State Senate, the 40th District delegation announced today.

Representatives Don Eldridge and Duane Berentson introduced the measure in the House and pushed it through to final passage. Senator Ralph Rickdall handled the resolution in the Senate.

At the time the resolution was introduced, Eldridge said it would be helpful to tie together the loose ends of other studies and to gather a more comprehensive body of local opinion.

Berentson indicated the interim committee on Highways, Streets and Bridges would probably hold a hearing in the County to consider local opinion both pro and con on the project.
